
GDPR General Data Protection Regulation

You'll need to get in touch with your Supervisory Authority.

Your Supervisory Authority Every EU country has them, and you don't need to register. (Phew!)


Data Protection Officers Larger companies will need to officially appoint a DPO to keep an eye on privacy compliance.



Subject Access Requests Must be completed within one month.



Data Removal/ 'Right to be Forgotten' People have the 'right to erasure' – meaning having data permanently deleted.



People covered Everyone in the EU. Even if the company dealing with the data is outside of the EU.

Consent No ambiguity. Must be given freely, not tricked, or taken from inactivity or silence.



PIAs Privacy Impact Assessments are privacy risk assessments that DPOs will need to carry out.
